<b>Question:</b>	Shall notified bodies inform other bodies notified under PED of all refusals, restrictions, suspensions or withdrawals of a certificate?
<b>Answer:</b>	No
<b>Reason:</b>	<p>Notified bodies, recognised third-party organisations and user inspectorates shall inform <u>the notifying authority</u> of any refusal, restriction, suspension or withdrawal of a certificate.</p> <p>Other bodies notified under PED shall be provided with information only on <u>negative conformity assessment results</u> like refusal to issue an EU-type approval certificate or withdrawal or suspension of a qualify system approval, see article 36 paragraph 2 and the procedures of modules B, modules D, D1, E, E1, H and H1.</p> <p>If a manufacturer informs his notified body on his initiative i.a. that</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>– the production has been suspended or stopped,</li> <li>– the manufacturer has asked to withdraw the certificate,</li> <li>– the manufacturer has selected another notified body,</li> </ul> <p>those are such voluntary cases that do not require the notified body to inform other bodies.</p>
